PURPOSE:

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize and assist desiring high school seniors to continue their educational school or post secondary school in the field of their choice.

CRITERIA:

1. Must meet Board of Regents requirements for regular admission to college or technical college off choice.
2. Must have good attendance record.
3. Must possess good citizenship and leadership characteristics.
4. Must be involved in school and community activities.

RECORDS:

1. Transcript of high school grades
2. Letter from candidate stating career goals and how the scholarship would be beneficial.
3. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member or a letter of recommendation from someone outside the faculty

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Application is open to any senior meeting criteria.
2. Scholarship award: One \$500 scholarship for the college or technical college of the recipient's choice.
3. All applications will be reviewed by the Education Committee of the local Crusade.
4. Applications must be submitted by May 8, 2024 to the Fitzgerald High School Career Center or to any officer of the local Crusade.
5. Interviews for finalists may be scheduled before a panel from the Crusade Education Committee.
6. Announcement of the scholarship winner will be made at Honors Night.

PAYMENT:

1. The scholarship will be given to the recipient upon proof of enrollment.
2. The student must be enrolled by the Fall Semester of the year the scholarship is awarded.
