  - Mr. Heitzman will contact Ms. Clements and Dr. Sims to access schedules under their leadership and pros/cons to both models
    - Current Jr. High model allows for more flexible scheduling (accelerated classes, female weightlifting, etc.) and more gifted funding. Test scores have not been as high since this adoption, but it's also been during Covid.
    - Previous Middle School model provided additional planning and grade levels remained separated. Test scores were highest during that time.

- BHMS will achieve a score 50.0 in content mastery for Math on the GMAS
- o Improve communication with parents and stakeholders
  - Request was made to provide detailed GMAS scores to all stakeholders (including teachers, students, parents and/or guardians)
- Employability Grade (will be 10% of student's grade) implementation has begun
  - o Preparedness: showing up with the materials to learn
  - Positivity: having a positive attitude to allow learning
  - o Punctuality: be ready to learn
  - o Participation: meeting the expectations to learn
  - Production; turning in assignments on time (evidence of learning)
